Love Him, love Him, love Him in the morning...

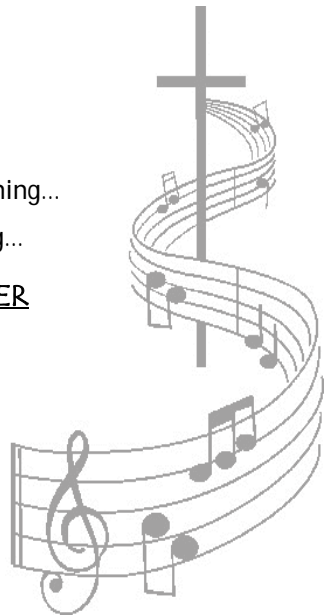
OFFERING HYMN - AN EVENING PRAYER
