FORWARD DAY BY DAY

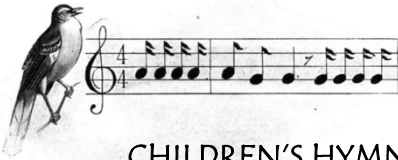
The new Forward Day by Day magazines for May, June and July are now available at the back of the Church. Please feel free to take one for daily reflection and inspiration.
